## PUBLIC HEARING

### Proposed Protective Bylaw Amendments 2017 Annual Town Meeting

The Harvard Planning Board will hold a public hearing pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 40A, Section 5, on **Monday, Feb. 6, 2017**, at 7:30 p.m. in the Town Hall Meeting Room, 13 Ayer Road, Harvard, Massachusetts 01451, to consider and receive comments from interested parties concerning proposed amendments to Chapter 125 of the Code of the Town of Harvard, the Protective Bylaw, to be considered at the 2017 Annual Town Meeting, which will be held on April 1, 2017.

The complete text of these amendments can be viewed at the Town Clerk's Office on the First Floor of the Town Hall, 13 Ayer Road, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. on the second Tuesday of the month.

The proposed amendments to the

Protective Bylaw are summarized as follows:

- (1) Amend Section 125-30C Land-structure relations – Height by adding additional text to clarify how height is measured; and
- (2) Amend the Protective Bylaw to add a new Section 125-56 “Temporary Moratorium on Marijuana Retail Sale” (which includes dispensing, processing, and cultivation activities, and other related activities to the sale, storage and distribution of marijuana) in order to undertake a planning process to evaluate regulation of marijuana and consider potential impact of new State regulations on local zoning.

The foregoing proposed amendments may not be numbered in the above sequence as they will be ultimately numbered in the Warrant for the 2017 Annual Town Meeting
