## PUBLIC HEARING

### Proposed Protective Bylaw Amendments 2018 Special Town Meeting

The Harvard Planning Board will hold a public hearing pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 40A, Section 5, on **Monday, Oct. 1, 2018**, at 7:30 p.m. in the Town Hall, 13 Ayer Road, Harvard, Massachusetts 01451 to consider and receive comments from interested parties concerning proposed amendments to Chapter 125 of the Code of the Town of Harvard, the Protective Bylaw, to be considered at the 2018 Special Town Meeting, scheduled to be held on Oct. 22, 2018, at 7 p.m. in the Town Hall, 13 Ayer Road, Harvard, Massachusetts 01451.

The complete text of these amendments can be viewed at the Town Clerk's office on the first Floor of the Town Hall, 13 Ayer Road, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8 a.m. to 7 a.m. the second Tuesday of the month. The proposed amendments to the Protective Bylaw are summarized as follows:

(1) Amend Section 125-45, 125-46B(2), and 125-46E to be bring these sections into conformity with Harvard Charter approved at the May 8, 2018, Annual Town Election.

The foregoing proposed amendments may not be numbered in the above sequence as they will be ultimately numbered in the Warrant for the 2018 Special Town Meeting.

Persons wishing to be heard on these matters should appear at the designated time and place.
