PUBLIC HEARINGS

Applications for Certificate of Appropriateness

Pursuant to the Town of Harvard Bylaw Chapter 48, Section 7D, the Harvard Historical Commission will continue two public hearings at their regular monthly meeting on **Wednesday, April 4, 2018**, at 7 p.m. in the Volunteer's room in Town Hall, 13 Ayer Road, Harvard, Massachusetts 01451. The Commission will consider comments from interested neighbors concerning the following:

- An application for a Certificate of Appropriateness on behalf of Ben Guthro, 13 Fairbank Street, Harvard, to repair an existing privacy fence and extend it 40 feet more.
- An application for Certificate of Appropriateness filed on behalf of Marc Sevigny, 74 Shaker Road, Harvard to resurface his driveway, rebuild an existing stone wall, and create a brick patio.

The Historical Commission will determine the appropriateness of the proposed work of these applications.

A copy of the Applications may be reviewed at the Town Clerk's office during normal business hours. Any person interested and wishing to be heard should appear at the time and place designated.
