## PUBLIC HEARING

### Town of Harvard Planning Board Proposed Protective Bylaw Amendments 2019 Special Town Meeting

The Harvard Planning Board will hold a public hearing pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 40A, Section 5, on **Monday, Sept. 9, 2019**, at 7:30 p.m. in the Town Hall, 13 Ayer Road, Harvard, Massachusetts to consider and receive comments from interested parties concerning proposed amendments to Chapter 125 of the Code of the Town of Harvard, the Protective Bylaw, to be considered at the 2019 Special Town Meeting, tentatively scheduled to be held on October 21, 2019, at 7 p.m. at The Bromfield School, 14 Massachusetts Avenue, Massachusetts. The complete text of these amendments can be viewed at the Town Clerk's Office on the First Floor of the Town Hall, 13 Ayer Road, Harvard 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. the second Tuesday of the month.

The proposed amendments to the Protective Bylaw are summarized as follows:

- (1) Amend Section 125-2 Definitions;
- (2) Amend Section 125-12 Small-Scale Commercial Uses;
- (3) Amend Section 125-13 Medium-Scale Commercial Uses;
- (4) Amend Section 125-14 Large-Scale Commercial Uses;
- (5) Amend Section 125-39E Fire Protection;
- (6) Amend Section 125-52 Ayer Road Village – Special Permit; and
- (7) Add new Section Chapter 125-58 Rural Life Preservation Special Permit

The foregoing proposed amendments may not be numbered in the above sequence as they will be ultimately numbered in the Warrant for the 2019 Special Town Meeting. Persons wishing to be heard on these matters should appear at the designated time and place.
