PUBLIC HEARING

The Harvard Conservation Commission will conduct a virtual public hearing under Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 131, Section 40, The Wetland Protection Act and the Code of the Town of Harvard, Chapter 119, Harvard Wetland Protection Bylaw, on **Thursday, Sept. 5, 2024**, at 7:35 p.m. on a Notice of Intent, after the issuance of an Emergency Certification, filed on behalf of Samuel Evonuk for the repair to an existing tailrace and foot bridge, and the removal of debris within the 100' wetland buffer zone, the 200' wetland buffer zone to a pond, and the 200' riverfront area, including land subject to flooding, at 99 Ayer Road, Harvard.
