## PUBLIC HEARING

At the request of applicant, Town of Harvard Department of Public Works, the virtual public hearing continued to Jan. 5, 2025, by the Harvard Conservation Commission, will be re-opened under Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 131, Section 40, the Wetland Protection Act and the Code of the Town of Harvard, Chapter 119, Harvard Wetland Protection Bylaw, on **Thursday, Dec. 5, 2024, at 7:15 p.m.** for a Notice of Intent filed on behalf of Town of Harvard Department of Public Works for roadway and multi-modal transportation improvements over 9,000 feet including replacing existing stream crossings and culverts within wetland resources areas as well as the riverfront area and associated buffer zones on Ayer Road from Route 2 to the Ayer town line, Harvard.
