Programmatic Environmental Assessment (PEA) and
Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for
Integrated Training Area Management (ITAM) Program Implementation
Devens Reserve Forces Training Area, Devens MA

The U.S. Army announces the preparation and availability of a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and Programmatic Environmental Assessment (PEA) for the proposed implementation of the Integrated Training Area Management (ITAM) Program on Devens Reserve Forces Training Area (DRFTA) South Post. Full implementation of the ITAM Program's management activities, routine maintenance, assessments, and repair and rehabilitation of training areas within South Post will include such activities as grass and woody vegetation management and manipulation, maneuver areas and trail repair and development, land rehabilitation, land manipulation, best management practices use, soil and erosion control, training debris removal, storm drainage repair and cleanup, and other similar activities. Assessing these actions programmatically will limit NEPA documentation and improve environmental oversight of these programs by taking a broad look at the ITAM Program.
